



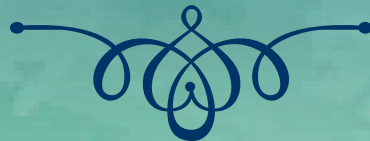

Montgomery Theater

I am going to the Montgomery Theater.

lobby

clapping

People clap when they like what they hear or see.

I can clap if I like what I hear or see.

People clap only for a short time then the clapping is over.

If the clapping sound is too loud for me, I can cover my ears until it is over.



quiet space

If I need a break during the show, I can go to the lobby for a quiet space. I can go back into the theater when I'm ready.



leaving

When the show is over, I will leave the theater room.

The room might be crowded.

I will wait my turn to leave the theater room.
